AACHEN

e-participation in the SUMP process

- ✓ 500 people participated at the workshop
- ✓ 270 people participated in the survey making 215 proposals
- ✓ 5 months later the “vision 2050” was unanimously approved

GDYNIA

Social Media platforms in SUMP processes

- ✓ 2,700 people completed the survey
- ✓ 65% of the respondents agreed that Mobilna Gdynia, platform facilitates the communication with the city administration

GENT

Participatory redevelopment of main station area

- ✓ More than 850 answered questions from citizens received via post, e-mail, website, personal contact

PALMA

Social Media platforms in SUMP processes

- ✓ By May 2014, more than 50,000 downloads of the App for real time bus departure information have been registered just on the Android platform

ELAN

KOPRIVNICA

Develop a SUMP in a participatory process involving citizens and stakeholders

- ✓ 10 workshops with stakeholders
- ✓ 8 awareness campaigns for the public

LJUBLJANA

Include citizens in the update of the Sustainable Urban Transport Plan (SUTP)

- ✓ Participation grew from a few attendees to more than 100
- ✓ Inclusion of useful suggestions in the SUTP thanks to experts and citizens

BRNO

Demand-responsive bus service

- ✓ Thanks to a focus group with impaired people, 5 cleaner low-floor minibuses with interior designed for disabled were put in operation
- ✓ 34 more connections on 2 lines

Integrated accessibility planning

- ✓ 1 door-by-door mobility questionnaire
- ✓ 1,500 flyers distributed with a detachable part where citizens could voice their opinion and make suggestions
- ✓ 2 public presentations

ZAGREB

Stakeholder consultation on a new passenger terminal

- ✓ 19 stakeholders out of 21 responded and actively participated
- ✓ 6 stakeholder meetings
- ✓ 300,000 copies of zagreb.hr (newspaper) distributed
- ✓ 2 presentations with citizens with debates organized
