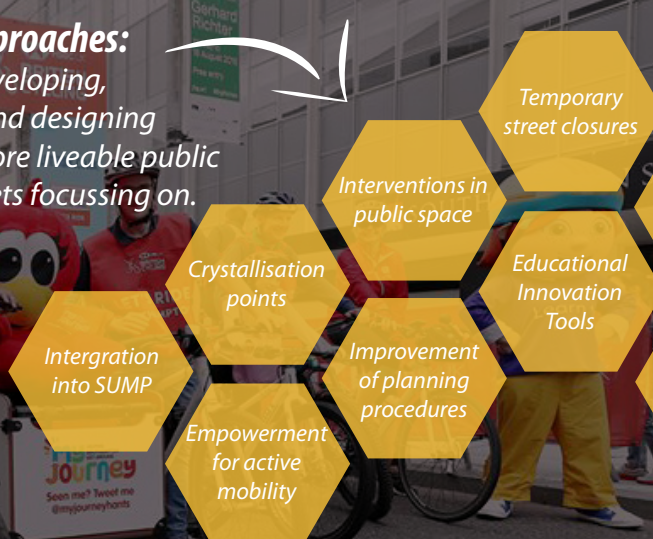
Children as:
