Community Impact

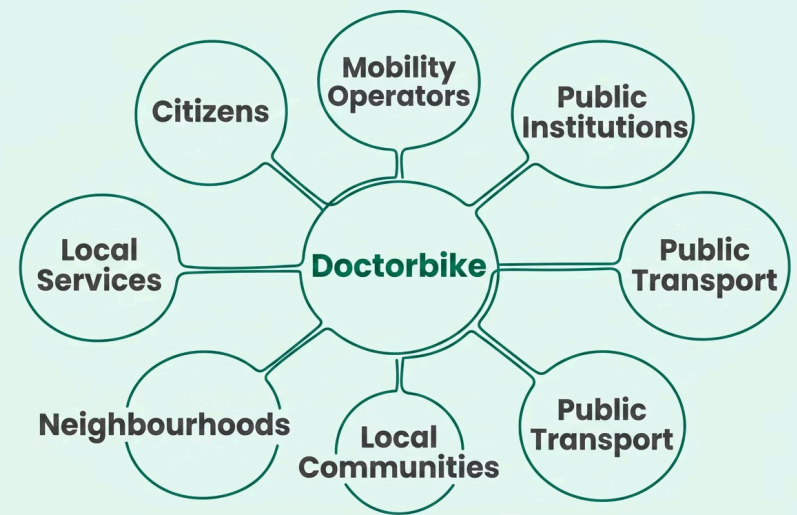
Our social inclusion activities bring people together around bikes, building local bonds and making sustainable transport a shared value across neighbourhoods.
