Information network for PT in Suceava



An outstanding step in promoting cleaner and better transport in Suceava was the implementation of 15 new buses in March 2006. In order to increase the interest and usage levels, LPTC staff established a route plan, consisting of 8 routes crossing the main residential areas of the city including the industrial, shopping and main street areas. Four of these routes have been declared Eco–routes and will be run only with buses equipped with EURO 3 or 4 engines; in the future they will be accessed only by clean and energy efficient public transport.
